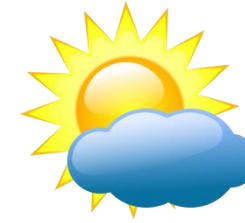




Year 1 Newsletter Spring 1 2019

Phonics



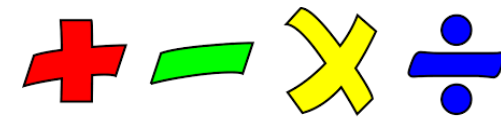
Over the next half term we will be starting to carry out a practise phonics screening assessment with your child. This will be described as a 'fun phonics challenge.' We will discuss the results from this at the next parents evening. If you would like to speak to us before, please do so.

Reading



Well done to all the children who have made progress in the Reading Challenge. Please continue to read with your child home and to ask them questions about what they have read.

Maths



This half term in maths we will be looking at odd and even numbers up to 20. We will also be looking at names of 2D and 3D shapes, measures and sequencing days of the week and months of the year. We will be continuing to reinforce addition and subtraction facts for numbers to 20.

Science



In Science, we will be looking at weather in our local area and comparing it to other places in the world. We will also be recording our own weather and looking at weather forecasts.

Writing



This half term in English, we will be writing letters, stories and a non-fiction report. Please continue to practise letter formation and share non-fiction texts with your child
