

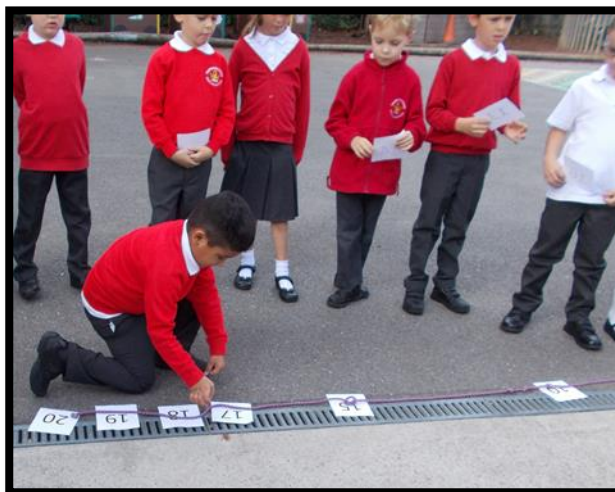

Year 2 – Number Lines

Year 2 have been refreshing their maths skills this week and used a partially completed number line to place the numbers 1 – 20 in the right order along it. Ordering numbers is an important skill and they used the numbers that were already on the number line as benchmarks to complete the task correctly.

They will be using a number line to solve maths questions during their time in year 2.



Year 1 – Measuring

Year 1 had a great time measuring body parts this week. They drew round a classmates body and then measured arms, legs, hand and feet etc. Instead of using rulers to measure they used cubes.

Some of the children drew round classmates and then labelled all the different body parts.

Reception – Feelings

Our reception classes have had a really busy week of lessons and getting to know their new school and all the staff.

They have experienced a whole range of feelings and emotions since they started and they have been discussing these in class.

The children used a variety of resources to make faces to express their feelings.
