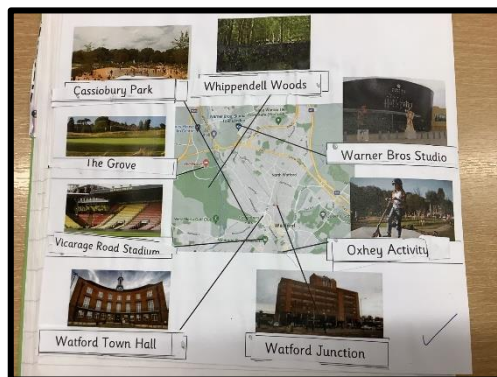
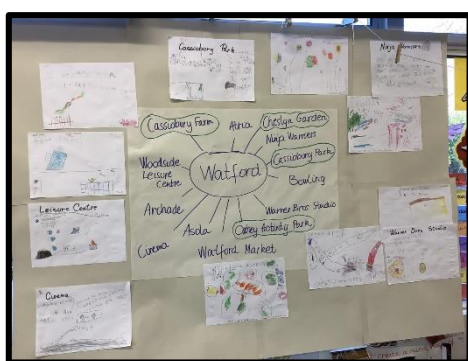
Kevin in Orange for amazing writing using his phonics

Reception In Literacy we have been talking about friendships. We used our phonics to help us write about what makes a good friend. In Maths we have continued looking at classification. We looked at the different attributes of objects and how sometimes some attributes overlap different classifications



Year 1 We have been learning about Watford and its main landmarks. In English we wrote a report about Watford and the activities you can do in this town. In Maths we explored number sentences and finding more and less than a given number. In Science we had fun exploring shadows and finding out about day and night.



Year 2 This week, we were lucky enough to be visited by a soldier from World War 1. He taught us all about what it was like to be a soldier in the war. We learnt how to stand to attention, what it would have been like to live in trenches, how soldiers were made to sign up to fight and the medical tests they had to pass to join the army. We also found out that women were not allowed to fight in the war because people didn't think they were strong or brave enough so they had important jobs to do at home. It was so much fun and we learnt lots.

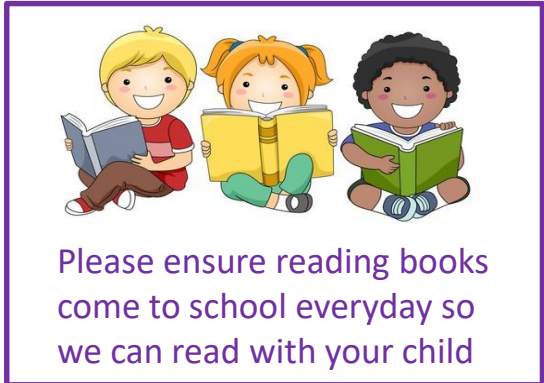
