

This week we have had some visitors from Herts County Council, they commented on how well our reception children have settled into school life. It has been lovely to see so many parents attend our 'Meet the Teacher' sessions over the last couple of weeks. All information from the meetings has been sent out to you today via Arbor, and has been put onto our website. Our school library is now up and running and your child will have the opportunity to choose their own book to bring home and share with you. Have a lovely weekend and we look forward to seeing you all again on Monday.



In reception this week we have used the book 'All Are Welcome' to discuss how we are all unique and how we welcome everybody at school. We talked about the different things we are all good at and the children drew a picture of their special talent. In Maths we have continued to look at the pattern of number and have explored when a number is bigger, smaller or the same as another. We have worked hard on using this mathematical language.



Year 1 have been looking at non-fiction texts about our body. We labelled our body parts and discussed the stages of growing and the changes to our body as we grow.

We played the Guess Who game, looking at baby photos and trying to guess who might be in the picture. It was really fun! Can you guess who we are?

In Maths we have been exploring numbers and finding different ways to represent them, eg how many ways can you show 8?



This week in Year 2, we have been continuing our learning about Superheroes. In design and technology, we designed and made our own superhero masks. We are going to evaluate these and then stick them onto our self-portraits. Aren't they amazing! In Maths we have been learning about odd and even numbers. We used Numicon to help us to see if the number was odd or even.




