All children have been busy creating some very special cards this week, therefore, I would like to wish you all a restful Mother's Day!



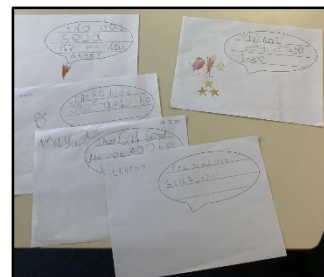
## Head Teacher's Award

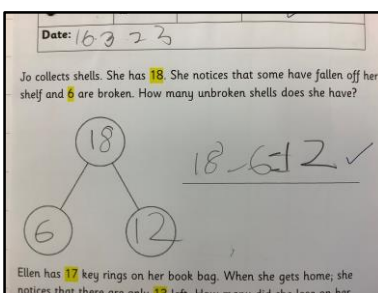
**Reception** This week we have been reading The Bad Seed. The children have been thinking about feelings and how the bad seed changed to a good seed. We learnt that we all are good seeds and that it's important to show kindness to our friends. We have been busy planting flowers and have been watching how our seeds and flowers are growing and changing. The children have learnt how important water and sun are to help fruit, vegetables and seeds to grow.



**Year 1** This week in English we used drama to act out the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. Then we wrote a recount of the story. We thought carefully about using time conjunctions and adjectives to make our sentences more interesting. In Maths, we were working on solving word problems using addition and subtraction to find the answer. In Design and Technology we made a slider mechanism, helping Jack to get to the top of the beanstalk.



**Year 2** In RE, we learnt about the Jewish celebration of Passover. We looked at the various traditional food items that are eaten and learnt that they eat matzah bread in between each food. In Maths, we looked at the links between division and fractions and how we can use our knowledge of division to find fractions of amounts.
