## A Message From Mrs Knights

*Welcome to the start of the summer term. We are hoping that the sun continues to shine, particularly for all of the outdoor activities we have planned this term! It has been lovely to welcome everyone back to school, I am sure that everyone has grown taller over the holidays!! The children have all enjoyed being back in school, and I am particularly proud of everyone who took part in the verse speaking heats, I know it was so difficult for the staff to judge. I wish you all a restful weekend and look forward to seeing you all on Monday.*

**Year 1** This week in English we were looking at poetry. We enjoyed exploring repetition in a poem. We became poets and wrote our own poem. In Maths, we learned about money and how we can use different combinations of coins to make the same value. Can you think of different ways to make 6p? In Art, we were making prints with our hands using primary colours. As we were adding more prints to our picture, the paints started to mix and created secondary colours.



**Reception** We are learning all about minibeast this term, and have some new friends in our class! We have been discussing what we know about minibeast and what we want to find out, for example where they live, what they eat and what they can do? In Maths, we have been finding the missing number in a sum. For example, if the total is 5 and one number is 2, then the missing number is 3.

**Year 2** This week, in English, we started learning about poetry containing similes. A simile is used to compare a noun to another noun. The children wrote some amazing similes of their own, including "My friend is as kind as an angel." or "Grandad is as gentle as a raindrop,". We also started our science topic on plants. The children classified seeds and bulbs and described the differences between them. We learnt that a bulb always needs to be planted upright, but a seed can be planted in various positions.

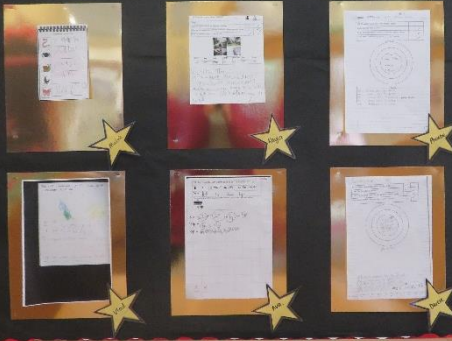
