Year 2 In Art, we learnt about Lorna Crane, who is an artist inspired by the Australian landscapes. Instead of buying her paint brushes, she makes them from items that she collects. We sketched some items that we could collect to create our own paintbrushes, like rocks, acorns, feathers and sticks! In computing, we learnt about what a computer is. A computer has a 'brain' called a microprocessor, this is able to follow the instructions that we give it. Computers also have a memory to remember the instructions. We identified computers using 'Nina Go Digital'.





















Year 1 In Art we started our unit about spirals. We worked in pairs and used different mediums such as pastels, crayons and pens to explore making different sized spirals on some large paper. We really enjoyed looking at all of the pieces of art and seeing how everyone's spiral art was so different. We also discussed how different spirals can reflect different feelings. In P.E we enjoyed our first two lessons focusing on running, including the correct running technique. We had lots of fun playing a game called 'sticky glue' where we applied our running skills to quickly get to floor markers and avoid defenders.
