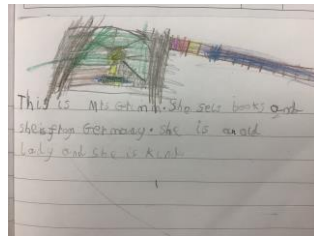
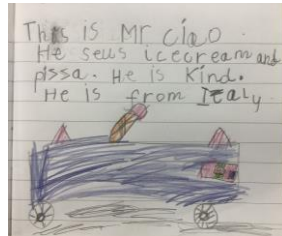
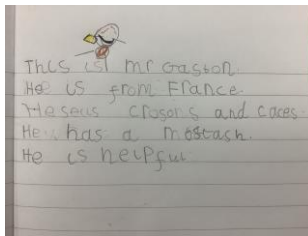
## Head Teacher's Award

**Year 1** In English, we read the story 'Madlenka'. She tells about her special news to the people who lives in her local area. We met the different characters and found out what they do and where they come from. Then we wrote about them, using capital letters for names and places. In PSHE, our topic is healthy me, where we thought about how we can keep ourselves healthy. In Science, we named and classified animals, talking about their features. This helped us to know which group they belong to.

**Year 2** We have started to learn how to tell the time on an analogue clock. The children have practised making quarter, half and three quarter turns in a clockwise direction. We have also learnt to tell the time to o'clock and half past, next week we will continue learning to tell the time. In science, we started our topic learning about 'materials'. We looked at objects made of different materials. We grouped the objects based on the properties of the materials they were made from.



**Reception** This term, we will be exploring the fascinating topic of growth, examining various seeds and thinking carefully about what they need to grow and flourish. We'll also make connections to our own needs for growth, comparing the difference between plants and people. In Maths, we have been engaging with the concept of regrouping whole numbers. By using our subitising skills, we are learning to identify different parts of a number, recognising that while the parts may change, the whole number itself remains the same.
