This week one of the school governors, April Gilb, visited the school to look at the learning and progress being made in school. She met and talked with a number of children and was so impressed with their confidence in talking and with what they have been learning. Most importantly, they were all able to tell her how important it is to go to school and learn, so that they can get a good job when they are older. Well done, Kingsway!Year 2 We have had a busy week monitoring the germination of our seeds. Whilst carefully observing the growth of our runner beans, we planted cress. We noticed that cress germinates very quickly as it has already started growing! In art and design, we explored mono-printing. We used carbon paper to make a print onto regular paper. We did this by sketching shells over the top, which transferred
 onto our plain paper.


Reception In literacy this week, we have been reading "The BadTempered Ladybird". We imagined what the characters could say to each other and wrote speech bubbles. We've looked at fascinating facts about ladybirds and even tried our hand at writing our own. We then created "Who Am I" fact cards and had fun guessing which minibeast each fact card was about.
In maths, we have been exploring 10 and some more, we had a look at how many smarties are in a tube, sorting them by colour and then seeing if we could combine colours to make 10 and some more.

Year 1 This week in PE we continued to develop our ball control skills. We played the game called 'jump in the puddle!' We had to hit a target with our ball, thinking about the power we use to hit our ball and aiming accurately to get it into the hoop. When we hit the target we jumped inside the hoop and shouted 'Splash!!'
In Maths, we were exploring capacity, we looked at the volume of water in cups and described it using appropriate mathematical language such as full, empty, half full, almost empty. Then we compared the different volumes of water. Eg: My cup is half full and I have less volume of water than my friend.
