This week we also had an inspiring visit from 'Electric Umbrella', who had the whole school singing and dancing with them. Year 1 In Maths this week we were learning about number bonds to 20. We have been looking at the patterns and found out how knowing 3+7=10 helps us to find the total for 13+7. In Science, we identified the parts of a plant and looked at similarities and differences between two plants. We enjoyed watching our daffodil garden grow. Did you know it took 4 months for the flower to grow from the bulb?













Year 2 In English, we started a new text called 'Julian is a Mermaid'. We used the beautiful illustrations from the text to inspire our writing, writing sentences, using verbs in the present and present progressive tense. We also started our new topic on the Great Fire of London. We explored

what London landmarks look like now, discussing how these might be different from 1666. We then sketched the modern landmarks and painted them using watercolours.



Reception In literacy this week we have been reading 'Jack and the Beanstalk', we talked about it being a traditional tale and how it is a story that has been told for many years. We used our imagination to think what we would like to find at the top of a giant beanstalk and made our own versions of the story.
