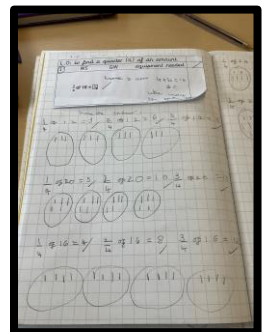
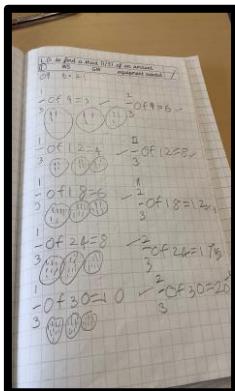
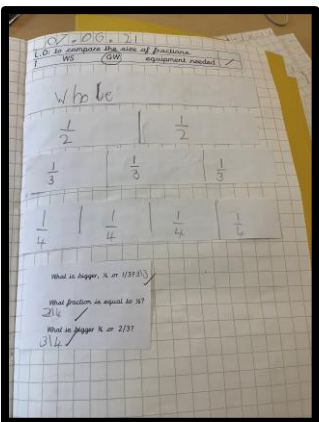
YEAR 1

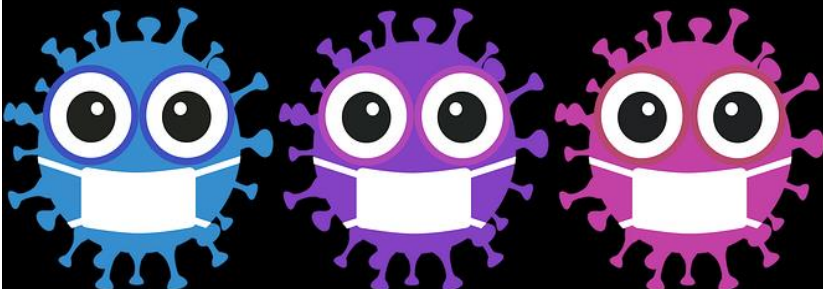
