In English Year 1 we have been writing narratives about our journey to school. We identified and described what we saw on the way using adjectives and joined two ideas together by using the conjunction 'and'. After designing our front cover and giving a title to our book, we shared our writing with reception. In Maths, we have been looking at the different coins we can use to pay for items and how to make different values that are under 20p. How many ways can you make 17p?

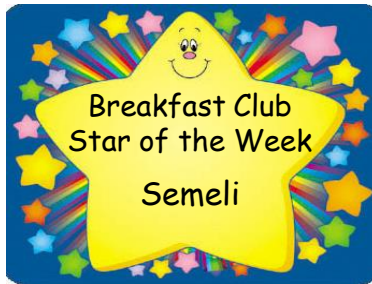


This week, Year 2 continued our food technology topic in D&T. We learnt how to prepare different foods by grating, cutting with a knife or chopping with scissors. We then got to taste test the foods we had prepared. In Science, we continued our learning about materials. We carried out an experiment to see whether we could stretch, bend, squash or twist different materials. We spoke about the properties of materials and how this impacted how they moved.



In Reception we have read the story 'The Enormous Turnip' We made our own books, thinking about the order of the story as well as learning about where different vegetables go. In Maths we have been using a dice to practice our subitising skills.

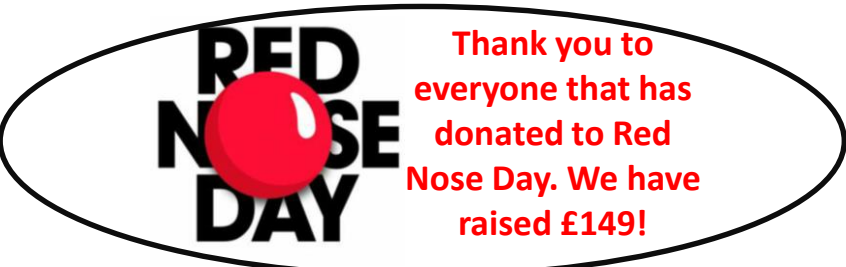
