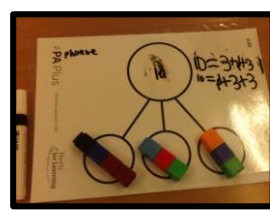
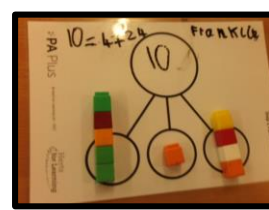
**Well done!**

In Year 2 we read 'How to Make Friends with a Ghost'. We really enjoyed the book and used it to inspire our writing of questions and statements. We also created our own ghost characters, using wonderful adjectives to describe them! In our science and D&T lessons, we made and reviewed smoothies. We have been focusing on how we can keep healthy and found out that vitamins and minerals inside the smoothies help keep us healthy. "They were delicious."

In Maths, Reception have been exploring weight using pan scales. We explored what it means to be heavier and lighter and how the size of an object does not always mean it will be heavy or light.

In literacy we have been looking at information books to help us find out about our senses, we went on a sense walk around the school and recorded what our different senses told us about our school environment, the school smelt very yummy at lunchtime!

As artists, we looked at the work of Wassily Kandinsky and created our own dot art we have made an art gallery for you to see at parents evening.
