Where learning is fun!



Year 2 On Monday it was 'Outdoor Classroom Day', where during our maths lesson we completed a range of physical activities which involved maths learning. For example, we counted the points for each bean bag that we threw to help us to make a total, we played games on the 100 square where we found odd or even numbers or numbers that were multiples of a certain times table and we played giant snakes and ladders. In our other maths lessons, we have been looking at number and place value. We played a game called 'make 100' where we had to regroup 10 ones cubes for one 10 stick.

























Year 1 This week we celebrated Outdoor Classroom Day. We took the opportunity to think about how we could take our learning outside. We thought about what games we could play outside and how we could develop the skills we have been learning even further. We had great fun! In Science we learned about our five senses. We thought carefully about which body parts we use to explore the world around us, like smelling with out nose or touching with our hands. We also talked about how our senses help us to keep us safe and alert us. Such as hearing a siren or smelling the smoke of a fire.
