

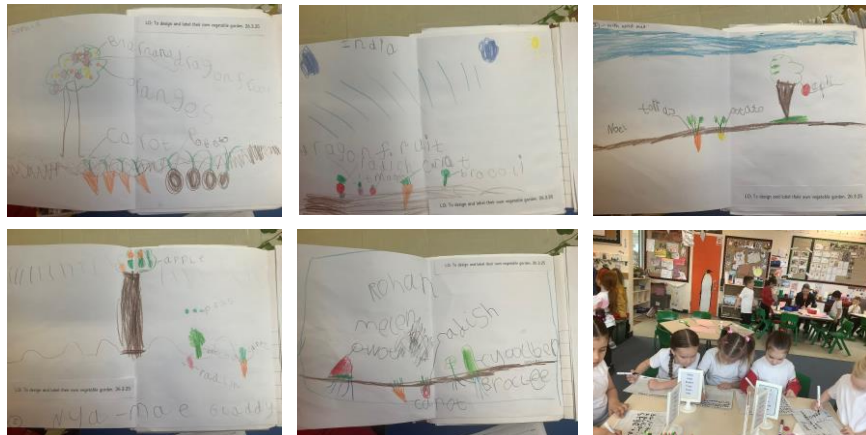

Reception This week in literacy, we have been exploring vegetables and discovering where they grow. We learned that some vegetables, known as root vegetables, grow beneath the ground, while others grow above the ground on vines, plants, trees and bushes. In Maths, our focus has been on exploring various methods to find the missing part of a whole number. For instance, if we have the number 5, and one part is 3, then the missing part would be 2, since 2 plus 3 equals 5.

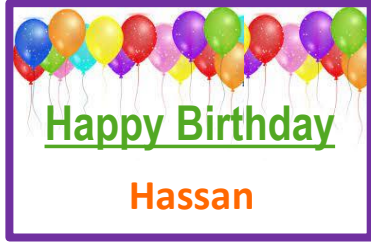


Year 2 In English, we have been learning about poetry. We started off by reciting poetry using our best prosody when performing. We then learnt what a simile is and used these in our own list poems! We wrote "Dad is as brave as a superhero" and "Mum is as cuddly as a teddy". In Science, we continued our observation over time, checking in on how our daffodil bulbs are growing. They are currently at the blooming stage so we can see beautiful flowers.

Year 1 In Design and Technology we finished making our puppet and evaluated our work, thinking about what went well as we were making it and what we could do next time to improve our work. We are looking forward to having our puppet show next week! In Music, we created a short sound and movement motif to match our characters: the Giant, Pixie, Dragon and Goblin and performed them to each other. In Maths, we were learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Where can you use these skills? What things can we count in 2s, 5s or 10s?
