


14th January 2022



Reception This week as part of our topic, Animals Around the World, we looked at farm animals in Europe. We found out about the different habitats of the animals, the names of the young animals and how they are different from the adults. We also found out about the different food grown on arable farms. In Maths we have been identifying a smaller quantity in a mixed group of objects and counting on from a smaller number to find the total number of a set.




Year 1 In English this week we were writing questions about old toys and finding out the answers. Also, we learned about the history of the teddy bear.

In Maths we have been estimating and comparing different objects and identifying which is the larger or smaller amount.

In Science we have been investigating materials and finding out about their properties. We used adjectives to describe them.

Year 2 This week we have been investigating the absorbency of different materials. We predicted which material would be the most absorbent and explained why we thought this, thinking about the strength and appearance of them. Using a pipette, we dropped water onto materials to find one that absorbed the most water.
