



What is this consultation for?

In 2024/2025, the Council's contracts for the Family Centre Service are due to finish. The Family Centre Service is made up of Family Support Services and Public Health Nursing. This consultation only focuses on the Family Support Service element.

We need to design how the Family Support Service will work from January 2025, and we want to capture the voice of children, parents, carers, and other professionals through this consultation process. We will use the feedback to develop a new service and to confirm which of the current premises we should continue to use.

We are proposing that the service will continue to:

- · Offer support, information, and access to childcare
- Offer support to live healthy lives and have healthy relationships (e.g. antenatal support, parenting, infant feeding)
- Offer support for parents/carers to return to work, education, and volunteering
- Support parents/carers whose children have special educational needs and disabilities (SEND)
- Provide information, advice, and guidance across a range of services and partners
- Promote public health messages (e.g. introducing solid food, promoting healthy lifestyles, emotional and mental wellbeing, supporting oral health)
- Include the family voice in the way services are delivered locally.

What are we consulting on?

As a result of previous parents/carers and professionals feedback, we are prioritising the following:

- Retaining the universal group sessions but charging families who can afford to pay for these
- Reviewing the premises we use to make sure they are fit for purpose, can be accessed by local families, and offer flexibility
- Supporting all families, but especially those children, young people and families who need it most
- Looking at where there is overlap, duplication, or inconsistency across the current service
- Learning from what has worked well in other local authorities.
